

2011 Hooper Rodeo Queen Contest

Dear Contestant:

Welcome to the Hooper Tomato Days Rodeo Queen Contest!

We hope this experience will become a wonderful adventure and memory for you and your family. To help you prepare for the competition, we have listed the requirements and general schedule. You will officially be entered as a contestant when we receive:

1. **Completed official entry form**
2. **Entry Fee of \$50.00**
3. **5x7 or wallet size picture**
4. **Reservation count and dinner menu choice for yourself, friends and family (Timbermine)**
5. **Dinner money**

Please mail all of the above to Hooper City, 5580 W. 4600 S. Hooper, UT 84315. Make checks payable to **Hooper City**. Entry must arrive by August 10, 2011.

The contest will begin on Tuesday, August 16, 2011. **This part of the contest is closed to the public.** Please arrive at 5:00 pm at the Timbermine located at 1701 Park Boulevard, at the mouth of Ogden Canyon. Contestants are required to wear prairie dress and give a prepared 2 ½ minute speech. Personal interview, appearance, personality and horsemanship knowledge will be judged immediately upon arrival. Parents and other guests are invited to arrive at 6:30 pm for the prepared speeches, impromptu questions and modeling.

Payment for the dinner for your guests should be sent with your application which will hold their reservation. The cost will be \$30.00 per person, which includes tax and tip. Menu choice is Halibut, Teriyaki Chicken, or Prime Rib. Please indicate your choices on your official entry form. (Contestant's dinner cost is included in the entry fee. Remember to mark contestant's menu choice.)

On Wednesday, August 17, 2011, the horsemanship portion of the contest will begin at 6:30 pm at the Hooper Rodeo Arena, 6150 W. 5600 S., Hooper, UT. Contestants will be judged on personality, appearance, and two go-rounds of horsemanship. The attire will be wranglers, shirt and hat. First go-round pattern will be on your own horse with second go-round immediately after the first and will be on a draw horse (the order will be determined at Tuesday's meeting). Please arrive no later than 6:00 pm. Have your horse warmed up and ready to go by 6:30pm.

Awards will be given for Appearance, Personality, Horsemanship, Speech, Congeniality, 2nd Attendant, 1st Attendant and Queen.

If you are chosen as the Hooper Royalty, you will be required to support and attend:

1. Saturday, September 3, 2011 afternoon and evening performances of the rodeo.
2. Baby show and Little Miss Pink Tomato, Labor Day, September 5, 2011.
3. All rodeo performances on Labor Day, September 5, 2011.
4. Hooper 4th of July parade, July 4 2012.
5. Hooper Tomato Days Jr. Queen Contest, August 2012
6. Other functions promoting Hooper Rodeo Queen that may be requested by the Committee.

Failure to attend all required events will result in loss of title and all awards.

Should Miss Rodeo Hooper 2011 meet the requirements of the 2012 Miss Rodeo Utah contest, the Hooper Tomato Days Fund will sponsor her in that contest.
